(To those who are baptized, Feet Purification should be done before Holy Communion)

Bible Reading: Psalm 23, Mark 14:22-25, 1 Corinthians 11:23-33

Preacher: In the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, Amen.

Order of Confession of Sins

Preacher: Dear Beloved! He that thinks I have no sin, will fall prey to deceit. If we confess our sins, God forgives our sins. He who does not confess will become great sinner and will be lost to God. Give your heartfelt answers to the questions that I ask now.

Preacher: Question 1: Do you confess that you have bothered heavenly Father's heart with your human birth, thoughts, words and actions?

Congregation: Answer: Yes, I confess.

Preacher: Question 2: Do you believe that Father has forgiven all your sins in the name of our Lord Jesus?

Congregation: Answer: We believe.

Preacher: Question 3: Do you assure to overcome all temptations according to God's promises by not submitting to any sin?

Congregation: Answer: Yes, we assure.

Statement of Forgiveness of sins

Preacher: To those who really sad about their sin, confess them and promise to be careful, I announce them as servant of Word, their forgiveness of sins in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. I also announce sinfulness to those who does not confess and who is in the state of sin.

All must say the **Lord's Prayer**

Order of Feet Purification

Preacher: Dear Beloved, at the time of supper, Jesus took a towel and wrapped around his waist. Therefore I am also performing that. It is the manifestation of having mind to minister. After that Lord poured water into a basin, therefore I am also doing that. After that Lord washed disciples' feet and wiped with the towel. Therefore I am also doing that. Lord told Peter, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with me". By saying "May you have part in the Lord", preacher need to wash feet of the congregation. John 13:12-17

Ceremonial Meal

Song of Praise:

Preacher: Give thanks to the Lord of Lords! For his mercy endures forever. Psalm 136:3

Congregation: To him who alone does great wonders, for his mercy endures forever.

Psalm 136:4

Preacher: Praise the Lord, for the Lord is good. Psalm 135:3

Congregation: Sing praises to his name, for it is pleasant. Psalm 135:3

Preacher: Our God Jehovah brought out his chosen people with shouts of joy. Psalm 105:43

Congregation: He gave them the bread of heaven and satisfied them. Men ate angels' food.

Preacher: We give thanks to you O God. Psalm 75:1

Sermon

Preacher: Dear Beloved, now you want to come to the Lord's Table. This is good. If you come because the Lord is calling, your approach is very good. If you come, because you are very hungry your approach is very good. As you receive the bread and wine that you see, let the Lord's body and blood do not be disturbed from the front of you. Fill your hearts with thanks. Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled.

Word

Preacher & Congregation: O Christ, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world, give us your peace (3 times).

Enshrine and observe Eucharist

Matthew 26:26-29

Jesus took the bread so I am doing the same. Jesus gave praises of gratitude so I am doing the same. Lord, thank you for giving this to us. Then the Lord broke the bread. So I am doing the same. Then the Lord gave it to them, so I am doing the same. **Take and eat, this is Christ's body given to you.**

The Lord took the cup. Lord gave praises of gratitude so I am doing the same. Lord, Thank you for giving this to us. Father, thank you for giving this. Then the Lord gave it to them, so I am doing the same. **Drink of this, all of you. This is Christ's blood.** Means it is new covenant blood which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.

Preacher: May our Lord Jesus Christ's holy body and precious blood nourish and strengthen your spiritual life and prepare you for bridegroom's advent and eternal life. Amen.

Let us pray. Preacher: Our Lord, our beloved Lord who comes as bridegroom, we are thankful to you as you have nourished us with your body and blood. Even though we couldn't understand the excellent operation in this communion, we greet you by believing it and its effect. Heavenly Father, by submitting our praises for all the intentions of making the holy food to your church through your Son, we pray that you give us your Spirit's exhortation to fulfill your intention. Amen.
